**DEMAND FOR INVESTIGATION INTO THE ROBBERY ATTACK OF MR
OLANREWAJU SURAJU AND HIS FAMILY**

We write on the above subject matter.

On the 28th day of March 2022 at about 2:15AM, five (5) armed men broke into the house of Mr Olanrewaju Suraju; Chairman of Human and Environmental Development Agenda (HEDA Resource Centre) situated at No. 12A Alfred Olaiya Street, Coker Estate, Orisumbare-Shasha, Alimosho, Egbeda, Lagos.

The armed robbers who breached his estate's security and burgled the security features of his house with sophisticated tools were heavily armed with guns, knives and other dangerous weapon.


The armed robbers clearly said that they were acting on information and instructions to kill Mr Suraju. However, they would not kill him if he and his family member co-operate with them because they felt he was a good person. They stole phones, iPads, MacBook laptops, bank token, ATM cards, jewelries, money, wristwatches, shoes, keys to all his cars and a car (Toyota Corolla, 2014 model with registration number KRD-142-FQ). They also collected the passwords and pin to his devices, ATM cards and online banking platform. They finally left after assaulting Mr. Suraju, tying them with belts and inflicting psychological and traumatizing fear on him and his family members.

The horrible incident was reported at the Afonka Police Station, Shasha, Lagos. Some Police Men from the Station visited the scene and even went away with a knife left behind by one of the armed robbers. However, we have not received any information or update on the progress of investigation 3 weeks after.

We hereby demand for a thorough and diligent investigation of the robbery attack on the house of Mr Olanrewaju Suraju as that is the only way he and his family will once again feel safe and secured.

Thank you as we hope for a progress report of the investigation soon.
